

Regional Competition Eligibility Requirements

CHORUSES

- All competing members of the chorus must be members of Sweet Adelines International and in good standing with their chorus.
- The competing chorus must be in good standing with Sweet Adelines International and with the region.
- A dual member is allowed to compete with each chorus of which she is a member. **Unless the dual member is directing one of the choruses, no special considerations is given for the draw for Order of Appearance.**
- No chapter-at-large member, associate member or member-at-large may compete with a chorus in a regional competition.
- A member of Sweet Adelines International may sing with the chorus of which she is a member and direct a chorus of which she is not a member.
- A member of Sweet Adelines International may direct the chorus of which she is a member and also direct a chorus of which she is not a member.
- Prospective choruses may enter regional chorus competition for **Evaluation Only or Open Division**.
- All competing members must appear on the List of Competing Members form turned in to the CC at the competition briefing.

QUARTETS

- Quartet name and personnel must be officially registered with international headquarters no later than **45 days** prior to the regional quartet competition, and be in good standing with the chorus and region, in order to compete.
- NEW quartets registered after January 15 are subject to a \$50.00 processing fee. Each chorus represented by the quartet must be in good standing with the international organization.
- Each quartet member must be a member of Sweet Adelines International, current on international dues and in good standing with her chorus and region.
- Chapter-at-large members may belong to a quartet and compete in regional competition providing the quartet is registered at international headquarters.
- Associate members may belong to a quartet and compete in regional competition providing the quartet is registered at international headquarters.
- Member-at-large members may be in a registered quartet.
- Registered quartets with members-at-large are **not** eligible to compete.
- A member may compete in two different quartets during the same regional contest, so long as they are in different competition divisions. No more than two members per quartet may compete in the second quartet in the same regional contest.
- There can be no change in personnel after the deadline date for late entries (45 days prior to the date of competition).

When the members of the quartet are from more than one region, the following criteria are used to determine region assignments:

- If three members are from the same region, the quartet must compete in that region.
- If members of the quartet are from two or more regions, the quartet requests permission from [Competition Services](#) to enter the regional competition of its choice. The quartet will compete in subsequent competitions in the designated region as long as the personnel and regions remain the same.
