Background

- The Arranger Education Task Force was established in March 2017 to recommend an approach to arranger education that would be broadly available to all members of SAI.
- The ACP Task force was established in March 2018 to “develop the modules and tests for the ACP as outlined by the Arranger Education Task Force and as approved by the IBOD, March 2018.

Why ACP?

- Support and supplement regional programs of arranger education while making arranging education available to all members in all regions.
- Prepare members interested in barbershop arranging for advanced arranging assignments and strengthen the pool of advanced arranging candidates Note: IMAP becomes the ACP Advanced level.
- Promote a better understanding of barbershop for all members, particularly those who need to choose music for competition purposes. This might include directors, quartet members, music team members and anyone who would like a better understanding of how barbershop is constructed and what makes it ‘strong’.
