I always love contest season! I love the rehearsals, the coaching sessions, the costumes ... but I especially love working to make this the best contest ever! This year the Competition Coordinator team is exactly the same as last year! I am your 2025 Competition Coordinator and Kim Machek and Desiree Hughart will be my assistants. If you see any communication from any of us, please read and take action, if necessary. We really appreciate your quick responses!! I know this part of this bulletin is long, but it contains a bunch of administrivia that I hope you will find useful. I encourage you to read this section completely!

Our setup will almost be exactly as it was last year. Our videographer will again be John Dietrich and Audio/Visual technicians, who are contracted through the Nugget, will be JamPro. The Events Coordinator is looking to replace the photographer, so look to future bulletins for that information.

Sweet Adelines, International Headquarters (IHQ) has made some changes to the structure/rules of contest. The big changes include: 1) changing the number of singing members it takes to make a chorus eligible for A and AA Division awards; and 2) there is a new contest division that allows choruses and quartets, that have qualified for the next international contest, to present their Finals Package and receive level scores and feedback from the judges. When and Where is the Contest?

Region 12's next convention and competition will be held on May 1-4, 2025 at the Nugget Casino and Resort located at 1100 Nugget Ave Sparks, NV 89431. The Nugget Ballroom on the 2nd floor of the casino will be the room where the actual contest is held.

How Do I Register My Group for Contest?

Sweet Adelines, International Headquarters (IHQ) will open registration for Region 12 on **January 17, 2025**. I will notify all choruses and registered quartets in the Region that registration is open once we have confirmed that it is, indeed, open.

What's a Division?

A Chorus or Quartet may choose to compete in **one** of **FOUR** divisions, one of which is new this year! The following describes each division:

1. Evaluation Only

- Sing two competition songs or medleys
- It is NOT a qualifier for any of the competitions at the international convention
- Performance should be not less than three (3) minutes and not more than seven
 (7) minutes in length
- Will receive written score sheets with level scores only
- Not eligible for medals or placement
- Not eligible for Audience Choice Award
- 2. Evaluation: Internationally Bound
 - Only choruses competing in the next International Convention (2025) and quartets who placed 2nd-15th place in the previous year's International Convention (2024) are eligible to compete in this division
 - Sing a performance package consisting of the following:
 - i. One competition song
 - ii. Emcee work
 - iii. At least one non-competition song
 - Performance is limited to fifteen (15) minutes
 - Will receive written score sheets with level scores only. Levels will not be published
 - Competitors in this division are held to the same penalties as Open Division Competitors
 - Competitors must obtain approval from the RCSC in order to compete. Email the CRC, Karen Fish (<u>muzcalfish12@gmail.com</u>), with the request. Please note: The region may deny Evaluation Only: Internationally Bound Division competitors participating in the contest if the longer performance presents a hardship to the region.
- 3. Open Division
 - Sing one competition song or medley and at least one other song or medley
 - It is NOT a qualifier for any of the competitions at the international convention
 - Performance should not exceed ten (10) minutes in length
 - The performance should be presented in an entertainment package with emcee material
 - Will receive written scores sheets with level scores only
 - Not eligible for medals or placement
 - Eligible for Audience Choice Award
- 4. International Division
 - Must be performed onstage during a live event
 - Sing two competition songs or medleys
 - Serves as a qualifier for International Semifinals and Harmony Classic competitions

- Performance should not be less than three (3) minutes and not more than seven
 (7) minutes in length
- Will receive written score sheets with number scores
- Not eligible for Audience Choice Award

Is There Any Other Way to Perform for Evaluation or Open Division?

Yes, any quartet or chorus, including prospective choruses and current champion quartets and choruses, may submit a video recording for Evaluation Only or Open Division by marking the appropriate box on the entry form submitted to the Competition Department at IHQ. Things to note:

- The official panel evaluates the recordings prior to each regional competition.
- Submitting a video recording does not fulfill the requirement of choruses to compete every three years in order to maintain their charter
- The chorus or quartet will not be eligible for any prizes or awards
- The chorus or quartet submitting a video recording may not perform on the regional contest stage for evaluation or placement in the same year

How Does International Decide the Order of Appearance?

The Competition Department at IHQ will conduct the drawing for Order of Appearance on 03/10/2025. For complete details on how the draw occurs, review the <u>Competition Handbook</u>. Here are the basic rules:

- For each contest session the Evaluation Only and Evaluation: Internationally Bound registrations are separated and drawn first.
- All other registrations are drawn randomly after that.
- Any contestant that indicated on their registration form that they wish to perform first will be handled separately and inserted in the beginning of their chosen division.
- Once the draw has occurred, any late entry will be placed at the beginning of their division after contestants who opted to sing first.

The Order of Appearance will be sent to the Region and posted on Sweet Adelines website. The Region will post the Preliminary Order of Appearance shortly after it is received. The Final Order of Appearance, that will include any corrections and late entries, will be posted approximately 15 days later.

What Will the Stage Look Like?

We will be using the same stage as last year. The stage is 60' wide by 40' deep by 36" high. It is built of 4'x 8' carpeted platforms supplied by the Nugget Hotel and Casino. The stage will be surrounded with rails for safety and black pipe and drape. On stage left, there will be a 4' wide, ADA compliant, ramp that will be used for all competitors to enter and exit the stage. The ramp will have non-skid runner to assist members walking up the ramp. On stage right, there will be a set of stairs with handrails. These stairs will only be used with permission from the Competition Coordinator.

For the quartet contest, there will be five folding sections that will form a backdrop for the quartet (same as in the past several years). Two sections will be on stage right and two sections will be on stage left and there will be a middle section. This set up will allow quartets to enter either from stage left or from the center.

For the chorus contest, there will be nine sets of 6' 3-step risers with the 6' back step. The middle riser section will be inverted. The outermost tips of the risers will be 12' from the edge of the stage. The measurement from the edge of the stage to the middle of the first riser row will be approximately 20'. An off-white choral shell will be placed behind the risers. Additional black pipe and drape will be used to make entrances and hide the backstage area. The stage will not have a curtain.

What about Lights and Sound?

Quality theatrical sound and lighting will be provided.

For the quartet contest, two small diaphragm cardioid condenser microphones will be positioned as directed by IHQ.

If approved by the Panel Chair, there will be stage monitors.

Chorus microphones will be flown overhead.

Lighting will come from a truss hanging above the stage. There will be lights between the risers and the shell so that all chorus members are equally lighted. The Audio/Visual technicians will adhere to the requirements set by IHQ.

Open Division Competitors can use up to three microphones; center stage microphone, stageright microphone, and/or stage-left microphone. The microphones will be set-up as listed on the Open Division Cue Sheet, which is due to the Competition Coordinator team 30 days prior to contest.

Depending on the number of attendees at the event, it is possible that there will be speakers half-way to the back of the ballroom to amplify the sound coming from the stage. These speakers must not interfere with the Judges, who are to hear only unamplified sound. The Panel Chair has the final say during the Official Inspection whether these speakers will be used or not. Once the sound has been approved by the Panel Chair, no changes can be made.

Will the Audience be Able to See the Competitors?

As in past years, there will be two large Jumbotron screens positioned at either side of the stage. The audience, wherever they are seated, will have a wonderful close-up view!!

Do We Have to Worry About Copyright Clearance?

Yes, it is up to the competitors to obtain the appropriate licenses for their songs. When you register to participate in the competition, there is language on the registration form that pertains to licensing and copyright.

IHQ is responsible for administering the copyright policies and procedures. There are 2 documents on IHQ website that can provide more information on Copyrights: 1) <u>Copyright Matters</u>; and 2) <u>Copyright and Licensing</u>. If you have questions regarding copyright policies and procedures, please contact <u>Music Services</u>.

Can We Sing a Song with Parody Lyrics?

Yes, but you must get permission from the owner of the copyright holder(s) and get clearance from IHQ. See the documents on Copyright listed above. You must also submit your parody lyrics for approval. See the links at the bottom of this section regarding the Song Assessment Tool.

Note: You will need to submit the parody lyrics and the email that you receive from IHQ approving the parody lyrics to the CC Team prior to the briefing. More information on sending the lyrics will come later.

Can My Friends and Family at Home See Us Perform?

Absolutely!!! Our webcast team will be set to provide a top-notch live broadcast from Sparks, Nevada directly to your loved one's most favorite video device! More details to come in future bulletins – so be on the lookout!

Will Photographs Be Taken?

Yes! We are currently looking for a new Photographer, but the process will be the same. The photographer will take all quartet photos at the beginning of the pattern in a quartet photo room. Chorus photos will be taken on stage at the end of the chorus' performance. More information will be sent to competitors after the Final Order of Appearance has been published.

Will Video Recordings Be Made Available to the Competitor?

Yes, you will have the opportunity to purchase a flash drive that will contain only your quartet or chorus performance. You will pay for the flash drive at the briefing.

If a competing group does not purchase a flash drive, per IHQ's requirements, that group will receive an audio-only file of their performance, free of charge, sometime in the weeks following contest.

Note: There will be NO post competition sales of your performance video.

I Use a Mobility Device, Can I Still Perform?

Absolutely, you can perform! Whether you wish to take your mobility device on stage with you or park it close to the bottom of the ramp or something in between, the Competition Coordinator team will work with you to make sure you get your moment in the spotlight. At a later date, we'll ask for more detail about people who will need to use mobility devices! Also, the hotel will rent scooters, wheelchairs, or other devices – look for another article in this bulletin or the next one from the Housing Coordinator regarding how to rent a mobility device!

Do I need to tell IHQ that my group has ...

- Changed Personnel?
- Changed Locations?
- Regional Affiliation Updates to Make?

The answer is YES! If you take care of these little details now, my team will not have as much work to do when we confirm you registration! It would be very much appreciated!

I Sing in More Than 1 Chorus, Can I Perform with All My Choruses?

Yes, the Competition Coordinator team will work with all Dual Chorus members to make sure they can change their costumes and get back into the pattern in time to take the stage with their alternate chorus(es). There will be a Dual Member Changing area just off stage on stageright. Most dual members will find that they have plenty of time to get off stage, change, and get back into the pattern. Occasionally, there will be some very quick turn arounds and we'll work with you to make it happen.

After the Final Order of Appearance has been published, an email will be sent out to Team Leaders and Directors asking if they have any dual members and which choruses they dual with. So, if you are a competing dual member, let your team leader and director know – make their job easy!

Are There Any Rules from International That I Should Know?

There has been a change on how choruses qualify for Division A and AA awards. Below is a table showing the number of singers required in 2024 versus the new requirement in 2025.

Quartets planning on competing in the 2025 Quartet Contest must register with IHQ by January 15, 2025, otherwise an additional registration fee will be assessed.

All songs that are sung in any Sweet Adelines International contest must have received an "Admissible" rating prior to its performance. Parody lyrics must also be approved. The original arrangement of the song must be admissible before the parody lyrics can be approved.
